

SITE 92 is an intriguing group exhibition at Smack Mellon, where artists examine and interpret the building itself — which dates from the late-1800s. Now situated in the heart of thriving DUMB, the building was once an industrial powerhouse, providing steam power for industrialist Robert Gair's empire. Trace the building's history, as well as its relation to its surroundings (including the adjacent East River), through the installation pieces of ten different artists.
